BOARD TO CONSIDER COUNTY HOME HEAD

Commissioners Likely To

Name Temporary Successor To Late E. T. Mangum

The appointment of a county home superintendent to succeed the late E. T. Mangum will be considered by the board of county commissioners at its April meeting tomorrow morning.

A number of applications already have been filed with County Manager D. W. Newsom and some of the candidates are reported to be marshaling political support in their behalf.

It is likely, Newsom said, that the commissioners will name a temporary superintendent and delay the permanent appointment until they have had time to make a more thorough study of the field of applicants.

The commissioners will meet with the city council at 10 o'clock tomorrow to appoint four members to the board of health. Those whose terms are expiring are J. T. Hicks, Dr. S. D. McPherson, Charles H. Livengood and Judge R. H. Sykes. It is expected that all or most of these will be reappointed. The appointment will be for two years.

Members of the health board whose terms do not expire for another year are Dr. R. L. Felts, Watts Norton, and T. C. Worth.

Another matter which will be considered tomorrow by the commissioners is the reappointment of J. E. Ferrell and J. M. Mangum, deputy sheriffs. The board appoints deputies upon recommendation of Sheriff E. G. Belvin.
