- I. Completing the survey of the County as to the needs of the communities.
- II Practicing the Live-at-Home Program. "Living-at-Home" means:
 - Adequate vegetable garden to meet the family's need of at least three vegetables per person daily (including one serving of potatoes daily).
 - 2. Sufficient fruit trees, vines and bushes to provide at least two servings of fruit daily.
 - 3. Cows to supply a quart of milk for each child and a pint for each adult (and adequate butter and cheese), 365 days a year.
 - 4. Poultry to provide meat and ogg supply throughout the year.
 - 5. Meat supply (hogs, cows and sheep) for year-around use-fresh, cannod and cured.
