*Martin Luther King, Jr.: From Montgomery to Memphis.* 27 min.

This film chronicles the leadership of Dr. King from his rise to national prominence in the struggle against bus segregation in Montgomery, Alabama, through his assassination in Memphis in 1968. Vivid newsreel footage portrays the inspirational nature of his vision and commitment against the awesome brutality of the forces of repression.

*I Have a Dream: the Life of Martin Luther King, Jr.* 35 min.

This CBS documentary is a stirring film biography of Dr. King. News footage of historic moments at Montgomery, Albany, Birmingham and Selma are blended effectively with highlights of speeches by the charismatic leader. Equal coverage is given to the civil rights movement as it evolved through the 1950's and 1960's.
