As of Tuesday, November 10, the new Library Take-Out! hours for East, North, South, and Southwest Regional Libraries as well as Bragtown and Stanford L. Warren Branch Libraries are as follows:

Closed Sunday and Monday.

Library Take-Out! has been in place since June and allows customers to place holds on items and, once the items are ready, to reserve a time to pick them up from the library lobby. Library customers can log in to their account online at DurhamCountyLibrary.org or call 919-560-0103 to place a hold on materials for pick up at the library.
