Biographical/Historical Note:	She has authored numerous articles and conducted extensive research on key figures in social justice movements in civil rights and labor issues and the arts. Her documentary project, Sam Reed and the Trumpet of Conscience, is a permanent digital collection of Duke University Libraries [http://library.duke.edu/digitalcollections/trumpet].
	DeLoatch has produced five albums and has appeared in clubs, cultural arts centers, museums, hotels, and theaters from Maine to Florida. She has appeared on BET on Jazz, WFXE [Columbus, GA], WNCU [Raleigh and Durham area, NC] and WSHA [Shaw University, Raleigh, NC] and at numerous festivals and series at Winthrop University, Coastal Carolina University, North Carolina Central University, and Duke University, among others.
	She has received numerous awards in the arts and for community service, including an Emerging Artist Award from the Durham Arts Council, the Limelight/Shirley Caesar Community Service Award from 103.9 FM and the Indy Arts (Community Service) Award from the Independent Weekly newspaper.
