The Delta Sigma Theta Sorority was established in 1913 at Howard University as a public service sorority focusing on educational, economic, and urban development, as well as community and international involvement, mental health, and the advancement of African- American arts. The first Durham chapter was established by two Hillside High School teachers, Mary Lee Fisher Morris and Minnie Pearson Turner Spaulding. Existing first as a graduate chapter known as Alpha Kappa Sigma, the Durham Alumnae Chapter was officially chartered on April 25, 1941.
