The folders include the church bulletin from the 1989 centennial services and from a 1967 fiftieth anniversary service, a 1995 mother-daughter banquet program, two audiotapes of the 1989 homecoming, several letters and clippings related to individual church members, and numerous photographs, most unlabeled. The scrapbook contains the history of the church from 1926, including clippings and photographs of pastors and their families, many photographs of church members and church activities, several church-printed bulletins and other documents, organized by decade. |
