Abstract:	The Durham Interagency Roundtable records span 1973 to 1987 and document the activities of the group of agencies representing efforts to improve education, health, welfare, and human resources in Durham. Items include organizational guidelines, financial reports, agendas, monthly meeting minutes, sign-in sheets, meeting RSVPs, and mailing lists. The collection is ordered in the following series: 1973-1976; 1977; 1978; 1979; 1980; 1981-1982; 1983-1984; 1985-1987; Mailing Lists; Finance 1973-1982; and Executive Committee, 1973-1981.
Scope and Content:	The Durham Interagency Roundtable (DIA) papers illustrate communication and information sharing over fifteen years between a varying membership of community agencies from 1973 to 1987. The collection contains loose materials including organizational guidelines, roundtable and executive committee meeting agendas, minutes and summaries, financial reports and monthly flyers announcing next meeting. Meeting materials from 1973 to 1976 included a call for North Carolina prison chaplains and the State of North Carolina Department of Correction "A New Direction: Prisons, Adult Probation and Parole" newsletter. Meeting topics and presenters varied and in 1978 included the North Central Legal Assistance Program, Child Advocacy Commission, and Community Planning Services (United Way). Meeting topics in 1980 included senior centers. In 1982 meeting topics and presenters included Durham's Dispute Settlement Center, industrial technology displacing textile, tobacco, furniture, and services to "violent and aggressive young people". Meeting topics and presenters also included speakers from the Lesbian and Gay Health Project, Community Kitchen (1983), North Carolina Independent newspaper (1984), and treatment of sexually abusive families (1984). Sign in sheets show a diversity of representatives from many social services organizations including the American Red Cross, Durham Hausing Authority North Carolina Independent Research Program, VMCA, Volunteer.

Rousing Authorny, North Central Legal Assistance Program, TWCA, Volunteer Service Bureau, Department of Social Services, Community Planning Services, Human Relations Task Force on Community, the Research Triangle Lung Association, and the Mental Health Association in 1977. Attendees in 1978 also included staff from the Children's Home Society, Durham County Health Department, Day Care Council, Edgemont Community Center, United Way, and Durham Day Care Council. Participants in 1979 included representatives from Project LIFT, Durham County Library, Retired Senior Volunteer Program, Drug Council & Evaluation Center, Agricultural Extension Service, Offender Aid And Restoration, NC Employment Security Commission, Hassle House, Eno River Unitarian Fellowship, American Lung Association, Durham City Schools, and the Durham Mental Health Center

Biographical/Historical Note:	The Durham Interagency Roundtable (DIA) was organized in 1973 and as of 1977 its organizational guidelines defined that its membership was "open to personnel of all public and private agencies and institutions in Durham County" with the purpose "to move toward a better service delivery system for meeting human needs so that there will be an improvement in the quality of life for Durham County residents." Members paid dues and an executive board of officers organized monthly meetings including guest speakers discussing community services in prison, healthcare, and education and services for children and seniors. Monthly meetings were held at the central YWCA on West Chapel Hill Street and later the Red Cross building. A lack of participation was cited as the reason for dissolving the roundtable in 1987.
