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Biographical / Historical

The East Cedar Grove Missionary Baptist Association came into being on August 10, 1895, when the Cedar Grove Missionary Baptist Association (established in 1868), passed the motion to divide their organization into two separate associations, East and West (with the Lynchburg and Durham Railroad as the dividing line) in an effort to decrease the burden of traveling pastors and messengers. East Cedar Grove Missionary Baptist Association continues to represent and support a united group of Baptist churches in Alamance, Durham, Granville, Orange, Person, Vance, and Wake Counties. The Association's main objectives were and are to develop and encourage Christian fellowship; to provide spiritual assistance to member churches, congregations, and auxiliaries; to enhance the quality of life within the greater community; and to support the General Baptist State Convention of North Carolina.

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Scope and Contents

The East Cedar Grove Missionary Baptist Association Collection consists of correspondence, minutes, roll books, yearbooks, booklets, bulletins, calendars, programs, and photographs that document the events, finances, history, and meetings of an organization of Missionary Baptist churches in Durham, Granville, Orange, Person, and Wake Counties in central North Carolina.

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Arrangement

The collection is divided into five series: 1. Correspondence, 2. Minutes, 3. Yearbooks, 4. Pamphlets and Printed Material, and 5. Photographs.
