Of particular interest is an oral history project Hogan completed at the Rougemont Senior Center, 1982-1984. Interviews and photographs of interviewees are included in the collection.

Biographical/Historical Note:	Judy Hogan founded her own small publishing company, Carolina Wren Press, in 1976 (incorporated 1978). She began a series of writing workshops at the Durham County Public Library, which ran from 1982 until about 1988.
