<b>Scope and Content:</b>	Material includes Emily Norwood Michie's genealogical research material, including correspondence, family trees and genealogies, family histories, research notes, transcripts of wills and a marriage bond, and applications for Daughters of the American Revolution membership.
<b>Restrictions:</b>	The collection is open for research
<b>Biographical / Historical Note:</b>	Emily Norwood Michie was the wife of John C. Michie, a manager of the Durham waterworks. Lake Michie, Durham's primary reservoir, was named for him. Emily Michie appears to have collected much of the genealogical material of the Norwood line during a forty-year time span, between 1900 and 1941. The family is of English, Scottish, Irish, and French lineage.
<b>Organization of Collection:</b>	Material is organized by topic and arranged chronologically or alphabetically.
<b>Container List:</b>	<p><b>Box 1</b></p> <p>1. Correspondence, 1855-1941, undated</p> <p>Correspondence is chiefly with family members discussing genealogy. Includes letter from representative of John Sprunt Hill.</p> <p>2. Last wills (transcriptions), 1781-1838</p> <p>3. Daughters of the American Revolution Applications, 1939-1940</p> <p>4. Family histories, undated</p> <p>Includes histories of Battle, Brockenbrough, Harris, Lanier, Martin, Norwood, and Washington families</p>

Includes genealogical information for Briggs, Crenshaw, Hoverton, Lanier, Macon, Martin, Moore, and Washington families

Includes transcript of marriage bond between Amy Martin and William Moore (1795), enlarged photocopy of indenture (1849) and deed (1857), history of Edinburgh, and drawing
