<b>Scope and Content:</b>	The collection contains documentation about Milo Pyne's work with the Eno River Association to preserve Durham's natural areas, particularly to prevent the building of Eno Drive. The materials include the Northwest Durham Parkway plan, which was presented as an alternate to Eno Drive by Milo Pyne, Brian J. Morton, Wayne Cash, and Donna Deal. In addition to documenting Milo Pyne's participation in Durham environmental organizations and activities, the collection also contains several hundred slides taken by Pyne and his father George Pyne, of downtown Durham and the Hayti neighborhood.

<b>Biographical/Historical Note:</b>	Milo Pyne (1950- ) graduated from North Carolina State University in 1991 with a degree in botany and is an ecologist at NatureServe. A native of Durham, he is an active volunteer who works to protect Durham's natural resources, particularly the Eno River. Pyne served as president of the Eno River Association for three one year terms, 2010-11, 2011-12, and 2012-13.

<b>Organization of Collection:</b>	The collection is organized into two series, Environmental Preservation and Durham Photographs. Environmental Preservation includes the subseries Eno Drive, which contains correspondence, publicity materials, and reports related to the efforts by the Eno River Association to prevent the building of Eno Drive in the late 1990s and early 2000s. Durham Photographs contains slides taken by Pyne and his father, George Pyne, from 1967-1996 to document Durham, particularly the downtown area.
