Biographical/Historical Note:	Southern High School opened in 1956, occupying a newly constructed building on Ellis Road. In 1993 the school moved to Clayton Road, and the original buildings were purchased by Glaxo-Smith-Kline. A School of Engineering opened on the high school campus in 2007, operating under the management of the high school. In 2013 Southern High was reorganized following a STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) model into four academies: the School of Engineering, the School of Business Management and Sustainability, the School of Biomedical Technology, and the School of Infrastructure Engineering. The school was renamed Southern School of Energy and Sustainability.
