Biographical/Historical Note:	The Triangle Land Conservancy (TLC) was formed in 1983 by local citizens to preserve open space in the Triangle. The group has opened multiple nature preserves and saved local forests and farmland from development. Their first project was the opening of the 270-acre White Pines Nature Preserve in Chatham County; they have since acquired more than 15,000 acres. The collection's donor, B. B. Olive, was co-founder and board member of TLC and served as the organization's secretary from 1983-1995. A pioneer in intellectual property law, he founded Olive and Olive, the first patent law firm in the Research Triangle Park area, in 1957. He served in World War II, earned an engineering degree from Duke University and a law degree from St. John's University, and was admitted to the bars of North Carolina and New York.
