Scope and Content:	The collection contains reports, publications, scrapbooks, audio tapes and other documents recording the history and activities of Carrington Middle School. Much of the material is accreditation reports, as well as documentation from the school's dedication at its opening in 1964. The collection also includes materials from the early years of the school library, including its participation in the Demonstration School Libraries Project, a state-sponsored program that allocated funds to schools throughout the state to improve their resources and serve as models of exemplary school library programs.

Biographical/Historical Note:	Located on Milton Road in north Durham, George L. Carrington Middle School opened in 1964 to serve grades eight through nine, with seventh grade added in 1965. The school was named after George L. Carrington, a surgeon in Burlinton, NC who donated the land on which the school was built. to the Durham County Board of Education. It was remodeled 1984 and 2005.
