Biographical/Historical Note:	The Durham County Chapter of the American National Red Cross was organized on April 4, 1917. Mrs. E.K. Powe was made temporary chairman, and Durham County was determined to be the jurisdiction of the chapter. President Woodrow Wilson signed a petition granting this on April 28, 1917. Mrs. John Sprunt Hill was elected the first Chapter Chairman and Vice Chairman was Mrs. M.H. Jones.
