# **Biographical / Historical**

Born in Gloucester County, Virginia in 1832, James Southgate moved to North Carolina in 1872 after several teaching positions. He founded J. Southgate and Son fire and life insurance company. He organized Durham Lodge #352 of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons upon relocating to Durham from Hillsborough in 1876. Southgate served as first "Worshipful Master" and was succeeded by Julian S. Carr. He died in 1914 and is buried in Maplewood Cemetery. He and his wife Delia Haywood had a daughter Mrs. Mattie Southgate Jones and son James Haywood Southgate (July 12, 1859 – September 29, 1916) who served as a trustee of Trinity College and Duke University.
