Notable 1907 Trinity College class members include Mary Lillian Duke (later Biddle; daughter of Benjamin N. Duke) and Hersey Everett Spence (Professor of Religious Education and Biblical Literature at Duke University from 1918 to 1952). The album also includes photographs of Trinity College president John C. Kilgo and the entrance to Trinity College, including the metal entrance archway inscribed with "Trinity College", "Eruditio" and "Religio" and the Washington Duke building.
